Website Cookies Policy

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

At present, only strictly necessary cookies are set on our website (see the table further below for details). No analytical, functionality or targeting cookies are currently in use. If this changes, we will update this policy and our cookie banner accordingly. We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. These essential cookies are always enabled because our website won't work properly without them. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services. You can switch off these cookies in your browser settings but you may then not be able to access all or parts of our website.
- **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose so that they can serve you with relevant advertising on their websites.

We do not share the information collected by the cookies with any third parties. The website does not currently use Google Analytics, Google Tag Manager, Meta Pixel or any other analytics or advertising tracking scripts. If any analytics, pixels, embedded media, CRM tools, maps, form integrations or other third-party scripts are added in future, we will rescan the site and update this policy accordingly.

1. CHOICES ABOUT COOKIES

You can choose which analytical, functionality and targeting cookies we can set by clicking on the button(s):

Our website uses a cookie consent banner (provided by CookieYes) which appears the first time you visit. The banner gives you the following options with equal prominence: Accept All (allow all categories of cookies), Reject All (refuse all non-essential cookies), and Customise / Preferences (choose which categories of cookies to allow).

Non-essential cookies are blocked unless you actively give consent. Your choice is stored and will be respected on later visits. You can change your preferences at any time via the cookie banner.

At present, only strictly necessary cookies are set on our website, so selecting "Reject All" will have the same practical effect as "Accept All" until additional cookies are introduced. The categories below indicate the standard options available through the banner:

Strictly necessary cookies **ALWAYS ACTIVE**

Analytical or performance cookies **OFF** (none currently in use)

Functionality cookies **OFF** (none currently in use)

Targeting cookies **OFF** (none currently in use)

You can also choose to "Reject All" cookies in the cookie banner.

However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.

Except for essential cookies, all cookies will expire after 1 year.

At present, the only cookie set is the CookieYes consent cookie, which expires after 1 year. The expiry periods for any further cookies will be set out in the table above.
